What will you learn?

Using a selection of simple embroidery stitches you will learn how to combine different techniques to create original and unique exotic flowers patterns.

Some previous experience of simple embroidery will be useful as this is not a complete novices class! A working knowledge of simple stitches like chain, satin and blanket will be helpful to you.

Who is your tutor?

By day Jemima divides her time between being a silver jewellery designer/maker, and an embroiderer maker and teacher. Inspired by flowers, fruit, mushrooms and lichen she creates embroideries that are stitched on to fabric ecodyed in her kitchen, and lovingly sewn in an armchair in the corner of the dining room!

Jemima has taught jewellery techniques, crochet and embroidery in Bristol and further afield, but the quiet and peaceful nature of sewing is the one she most enjoys teaching. Though Jemima uses simple, 'oldfashioned' stitches, you'll learnt to use them in a fresh and original way.
