#### ***What will you learn?***

Why not join Caroline and Nigel for a fantastic day of block printing on fabric?

You don't need to be an artist to enjoy Indian Block Printing! In this relaxed session, you will learn how easy it is to create wonderful images on a range of fabric items such as T towels, aprons, napkins, table runners, bags etc. using traditional hand carved Indian wood blocks and fabric paints.

Between them Caroline and Nigel have literally hundreds of sustainably sourced Indian wood blocks for you to choose from, and you won't believe how simple it is to get some really fantastic results.

This workshop is suitable for all abilities, whether you have printed before or not. Caroline and Nigel will bring lots of ideas and samples to help you get started and they will be on hand throughout the day to guide you through the process, from start to finish.

#### ***Who are your tutors?***

You may already know Caroline Lambert and Nigel Ginley from their Stained-Glass teaching but they also have a passion for block printing and are keen to share it with others!

Nigel creates, exhibits and sells a range of unique block craft items. He is a familiar face at Kingshill House as a Trustee and he also helps his wife Jackie with the very popular Crafty Thursday drop-in sessions.

Caroline teaches stained glass full time but she very much enjoys the occasional day helping Nigel in teaching Indian block printing.
