

MULTI BLOCK LINO PRINTING
WITH BETH JENKINS
15 JULY 2020 – 10AM – 4PM



What will you learn?

Learn how to take your colour lino printing to the next level by using a different block for each colour. You will learn how to register your prints successfully so that all the layers of colour match up and how to make a simple registration device. You will also learn how to transfer your design to each block in an accurate way. We will be working on A6 blocks, with a maximum of 2 colours plus white. As this is a time consuming process, it would be good to keep your designs simple, unless you are an experienced linocutter. Suitable for those who have some basic lino cutting experience and those who would like to expand their existing knowledge.

Who is your tutor?

Beth specialises in woodblock and lino printmaking and is a member of Gloucestershire Printmaking Co-op. Beth has been teaching for a number of years and likes to build confidence in her students with encouragement and enthusiasm.

She has degrees in Fine Art and Creative Practices and exhibit widely throughout the UK.

Are there any additional costs?

There is an additional cost of approximately £7 for materials payable in cash to the tutor on the day



What will I need?

You will need to bring an apron, pencil and paper and some ideas for the kind of work you would like to make. (Sketches or photos or examples of other peoples work to use as a starting point) If you can't think of anything, don't worry, I will bring source material for you to use. You don't need to be great at drawing, there are lots of ways round this!

This is a reverse process, so if you want to use a sketch, it saves time if you can take a photo and reverse it on a computer if that option is available to you.

How do I find Kingshill House?
