What will you learn?

Learn how to capture nature in Silver Clay. You will learn various Silver clay techniques focusing on the textures found in nature, but also covering the basics of working with Silver Clay. You will make a pendant or earrings in Fine silver to your own design and finish the day wearing what you made.

From her studio in Gloucestershire Wizz Stearne creates beautiful silver jewellery. Drawing inspiration from her engineering heritage and the ever-changing countryside around her, Silver Clay allows Wizz to create unique, quirky and elegant Jewellery. Utilising her 3D design degree, she seeks to present this as contemporary stylish jewellery pieces.
