What will you learn?

Recreate the process first used by Fox Talbot, who produced beautiful sepia toned photographs.

We will mix chemicals to produce a light sensitive emulsion (photographic paper). We will lay negatives or found objects onto the surface using sunlight to expose the prints.

After washing and fixing you will be left with unique and stunning prints.

Who is your tutor?

Abi is a Fine Art photographer and printmaker. She has amassed a wealth of knowledge through her own practice and as a lecturer and educator. At Bristol School of Art she was Head of Department, and for over 10 years taught modules at degree level, on Foundation Diploma and adult education.

She is happiest when sharing her knowledge learnt at Brighton University, Barcelona and USA, believing in hands on experimental approaches to imagine creation.
