


WATERCLOUR & FIBRE PEN IMAGES

What will you learn?

Ronald will take you through an interesting mix of painting and drawing with this workshop.

You start by underpainting in watercolour and then draw in all the details with a fibre pen.

You can make an image of something you bring along or a photograph of anything you wish.

You should be able to complete two paintings in the day.

We will be setting out the basic colours in watercolour paint or pencils and the adding all the detail with fibre pen. This a great technique for both quick sketches and more polished works.

Who is your tutor?

Ronald has been drawing seriously since he was ten years old and won a scholarship to Portland House School of Art at twelve years old based on his drawing skills. He has drawings in public and private collections in the UK, Europe, America and New Zealand.

Are there any additional costs?
