WITH CLAIRE NICOL

What will you learn?

Learn needle turned applique to make a panel of summer flowers that can become a cushion or a bag or even the start of your quilt. Claire will take you through the basics and set you off. Work at your own speed and go away with all you need to complete the task if you don't finish. Fast workers can start another one or start to construct their product.

Who is your tutor?

A lover of textiles, Claire has worked with them in many ways, but always with the underlying theme of reuse and recycle. Claire particularly likes a craft that can be done with limited and easily available tools. Printing, patchwork and rag rugs are favourites, but applique, embroidery and others all play a part in her work.

Are there any additional costs?

Claire will have fabric available for you to buy on the day, costs £2-10 (cash) depending on requirements.



What will I need?

Basic sewing kit with scissors, thread and needles.

You will also need fabric for flowers and stems – these can be purchased from Claire or you can bring your own. You will need approx. one fat quarter of at least two designs. You will also need a plain fabric for the background. Size dependant on how much you want to do but Claire suggests A4/A3 sort of size.

How do I find Kingshill House?
