

## STAINED GLASS MOSAIC BIRDS

WITH YVETTE GREEN

15 - 16 JULY 2020 – 10AM – 4PM



### ***What will you learn?***

Create your very own life-like, large bird, up to 30cm in height for **indoor** use. The two day course will take you through the whole process so that you will have a completed item to take home with you. You will learn how to transfer your design onto MDF and how to make decisions about colour and texture to create a true to life look. The tutor will guide you on how to cut opaque glass sheets for use in mosaic, paying particular attention to colour blending. You will be guided through the process of grouting, given help to choose suitable grout colours and will be shown how to hang your piece.

Basic penguin shapes will be provided, but if you have a particular design in mind, you can contact the tutor **two** weeks in advance to discuss your shape so that it will be ready for you on the day.

Suitable for all levels but basic glass cutting skills will be a bonus.

### ***Who is your tutor?***

Yvette Green is a stained glass mosaic artist working from a small studio based near Cirencester, Gloucestershire. Originally from South Africa, Yvette trained in Botany and Education before working in mosaics for the last 13 years. She works primarily with stained glass and glass inclusions and produces mosaics for all areas of the home. Her work is inspired by the intense colours of nature and her love of the outdoors.

Yvette has exhibited widely around Gloucestershire, and mosaicked one of the large hares for the Cirencester March Hare Festival in 2014 and the Cotswold Hare Festival in 2017. She is member of the Cotswold Craftsmen as well as the British Association of Modern Mosaic.



***Are there any additional costs?***

There is an additional cost of £12 if you use the standard template or £16 if a template needs to be cut to your design.

Materials included in this cost are: All bases, glass, grout and tools

***What will I need?***

Please bring an apron.

***How do I find Kingshill House?***
